Doug Pugliese started as a mergers and acquisitions advisor in NY and London, where he worked as a managing director for Bear Stearns for a dozen years. Peter Conn was named Executive Director of The Athenaeum of Philadelphia in January 2016. He retired from Penn as Vartan Gregorian Emeritus Professor of English and Professor of Education, and was a member of the graduate groups in the history of art and American civilization, a member of the urban studies and Asian-American studies faculties, and an affiliated member of the Center for East Asian Studies. His publications include among others, *The Divided Mind: Ideology and Imagination in America, 1898-1917* (Cambridge University Press, 1983; paperback editions, 1988 and 2008), and *Literature in America* (Cambridge University Press, 1989), which was a main selection of Associated Book Clubs (UK). *Pearl S. Buck: A Cultural Biography* (Cambridge, 1996; Paperback 1998), was chosen as a "*New York Times* Notable Book," was listed among the best 25 books of 1996 by *Publishers Weekly* and among the best books of the year by *Library Journal*, was included among the five finalists for the National Book Critics Circle award in biography, and received the Athenaeum Award.
