Parris Watson, graduated Drexel University 1998 BS in Chemistry. In 1999 he returned to finish the MS in Chemistry, and finally returned again to Drexel University to finish the M.Scl (equivalent to M.Ed.) in 2004.

Mr. Watson had been a Chemist working a diverse array of end use applications. He later went on to teach Chemistry at the university level at institutions such as Camden County College and Rowan University.

In light of this presentation, Mr. Watson had started life in one of the lowest sections of West Philadelphia. Mr. Watson has used welfare state agencies in lieu of single parent upbringing. Mr. Watson also has the unique experiences of court battles with the Philadelphia Housing Authority, and battle with Philadelphia Office of Supportive Housing. As this is being prepared, he is going to court yet again against a HUD funded senior apartment.

A presentation on matters of welfare state agencies would elucidate why Mr. Watson is forced to be a dilatant at rather than practice the art and science of Chemistry. Also he would like to change attitudes towards negative and affirmative poverty stereotypes.
